INTRODUCTION BY MR. HOOTIE ADAM-EOC DIRECTOR

- Mr. Adam updated all governmental entities/representatives with the latest information regarding Hurricane Nate from the National Weather Service. At this time, he anticipates 3-6" rainfall by landfall and a 4-6 ft. storm surge watch is in effect. He announced locations where citizens could obtain sandbags and that at this time evacuations were on a voluntary basis for low-lying areas. He did say that Buccaneer Park has been evacuated. After further discussion, he answered all questions asked.
